Call to Action



Recent pro-life legislation approved in southern states is making an impact in Illinois -- in an unexpected way.

Supporters of extreme abortion legislation introduced in Illinois in February have been energized in reaction to the measures passed in other states. They are making a push to pass the misnamed "Reproductive Health Act" (House Bill 2495 & Senate Bill 1942) and a bill that would repeal current law calling for parents to be notified when a minor seeks an abortion (House Bill 2467 & Senate Bill 1594) **before the legislative session ends on May 31.**

We can't let our guard down.

As a reminder, HB 2495/SB 1942 go further than *Roe v. Wade* in eliminating rights for the unborn child, and jeopardize conscience protections for doctors, nurses and hospitals who refuse to participate in an abortion. Meanwhile, HB 2467/SB 1594 repeal current law calling for a legal guardian to be notified when a minor seeks an abortion. The law allows for exceptions -- including children physically or sexually abused -- as well as a waiver if notification is not in the best interest of the child. Every state that surrounds Illinois requires **at least** parental notification when a minor seeks an abortion.

Counting TODAY, there are 11 scheduled days left in the legislative session. Lawmakers have yet to craft a budget for the new fiscal year that starts July 1, decide on legalizing marijuana and sports betting, or outline a statewide construction program after years of neglect. This is NOT the time to consider an overhaul of the state's abortion laws.
