Qualifications

- Knowledge and flexibility in incorporating contemporary music into liturgical settings, while retaining an appreciation for traditional hymns and settings
- Leadership and organizational skills that are rooted in prayer and possess a collaborative style

Responsibilities

- Serve as principal musician, pianist, and choir director
- Prayerfully select hymns, Mass parts, and other liturgical music for worship, in collaboration with the Parish Liturgy Committee
- Coordinate music ministry that insures a quality musical element within weekend Masses, Holy Days, weddings, funerals, and other parish liturgical celebrations
- Report to Pastor, participate in staff meetings, and work collaboratively as an active member of the Parish Liturgy Committee
- Lead regular rehearsals for choir, cantors, and instrumentalists
